BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE



The long-awaited Building Project will start on 23rd July when the Builders will move in. It is estimated they will finish and we will be back in the Church by the end of March 2019.

The Gilliat Hall and Lounge is to be used for everything! Also until the first week of September, the Choir Vestry will be closed as work is taking place there, so it can be finished and used from then onwards when the school terms starts.



No Entry: The entire Church and Car park will be a 'NO GO' Area and no-one should enter it.

At all times, for your safety, please follow the builder's signs.



Entrance to the Gilliat Hall will be via a marked path along the side of the church. Once the Choir Vestry work is complete in September, the side entrance on the north side of the church, alongside Nadeem's house side, will be our entrance instead.



No Parking: On Sundays there will be limited parking space on the Drive which will be reserved for disabled and dropping off. Everyone else will need to park in the road or elsewhere. Please only use this if you absolutely have to, as it will quickly become congested and impossible to get cars in and out.



On Sundays it's OK to park outside the Church on the single yellow line. On Monday to Saturday parking is only allowed before 8am in the morning and after 7pm in the evening – but never with two wheels on the footway. Do not park in Keswick Court, or you are likely to be fined.



The last service in the Church will be 6.30pm on **Sunday 15th July**.



The first services in the Hall will be on **Sunday 22nd July**. Same services times as usual.

Safeguarding Training - SAVE THE DATE

Wednesday 3rd OCTOBER 2018 - Gilliat Hall 7pm to 9pm.

Last Autumn, many of the congregation completed basic C1 Foundation Safeguarding training. Anyone who has safeguarding leadership responsibilities or responsibility for leading activities with children, young people and/or vulnerable adults is also required to complete C2 Leadership Safeguarding Training and we have arranged for Rebecca Norris-Bulpitt from the Oxford Diocese to come to Slough to lead this training on WEDNESDAY 3rd OCTOBER 2018 in the Gilliat Hall from 7pm to 9pm. If this training applies to you, please make a note of this date and time. To complete C2 training you must have completed C1 training (which can be done on-line). C2 training has to be delivered face-to-face by the Diocese.

Following this training, Rebecca will deliver S1 Safer recruitment training from 9pm to 10pm which is required for everyone who is involved in the recruitment of staff or volunteers.

Further details will be given out later in the summer and individuals will receive personal invitations.
